### Internet university offers Ivy Tech grads tuition deals

Western Governors University, an online institution created by 11 Western governors 13 years ago and administered from Salt Lake City, has signed on with Indianapolis-based Ivy Tech Community College.

The partnership would mean a cheaper, fully credible four-year bachelor's degree Ivy Tech students. Also, Ivy Tech graduates are eligible for an application fee waiver, a 5 percent discount on WGU's already-affordable tuition, and a generous transfer policy, according to a news release.
