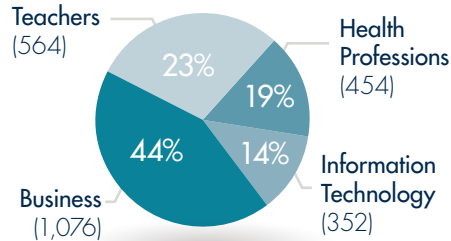

(As of March 2017)

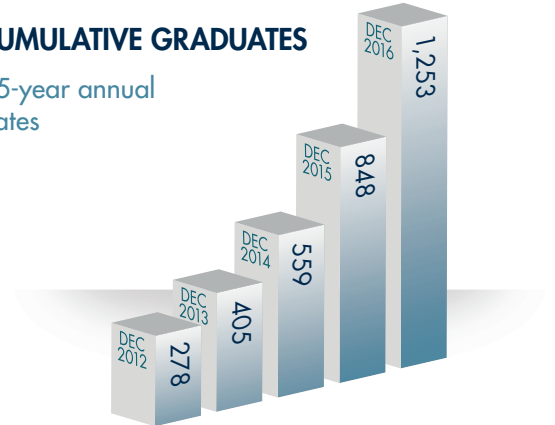

46% compound 5-year annual growth in graduates

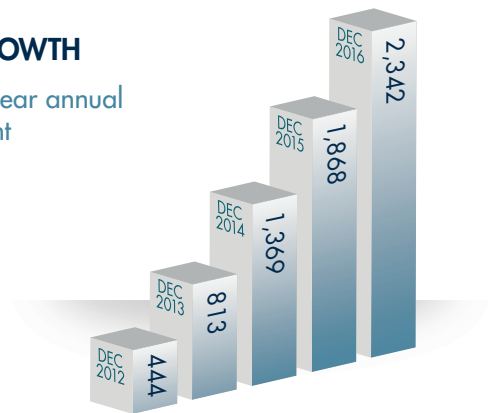


STUDENT SNAPSHOT

 - 24% rural area residents
 - 15% ethnic minorities
