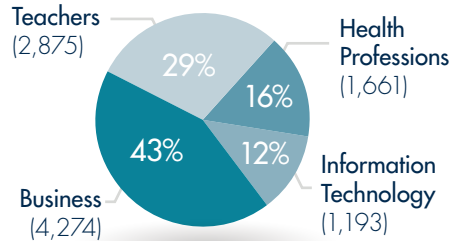

(As of March 2017)

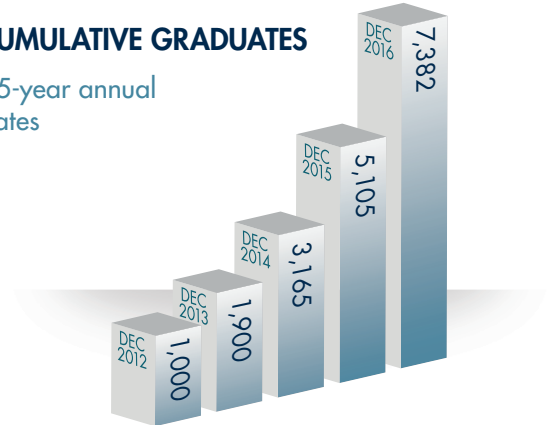

65% compound 5-year annual growth in graduates

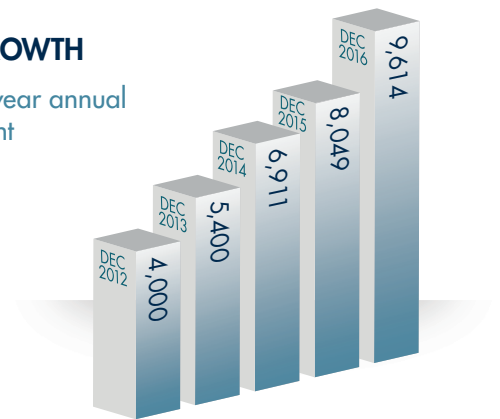


STUDENT SNAPSHOT

- The average student age is 37; student ages range from 18 to 73.
- 10% are active military, veterans, or military family members.
- 67% work full time; 16% work part time.
- 66% of students are in one or more of the following underserved populations:
 - 37% first-generation college students
 - 27% low-income families
 - 12% rural area residents
 - 22% ethnic minorities
